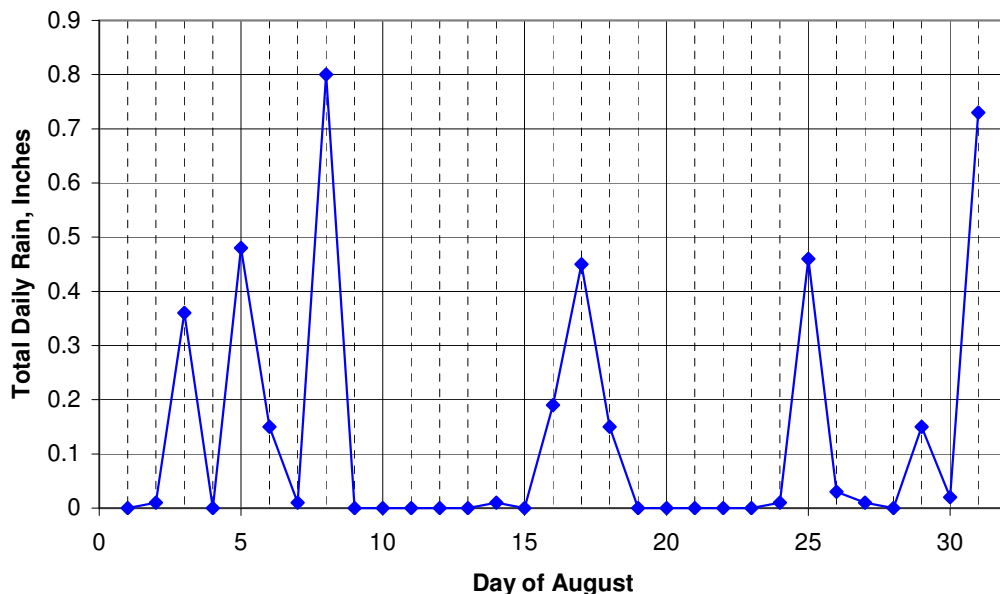

**August 2008 Daily Rain**



This is a summary of the NOAA Report for August (uploaded data from Pine Home Station). You may be interested in the high & low temperatures as well as the rainfall. I included the highest rates of rainfall for each storm ("Hi Rate"). Note that the last storm (29th-31st) came in from the SSW. The "Rain" column is graphed to the left. A great monsoon month!
