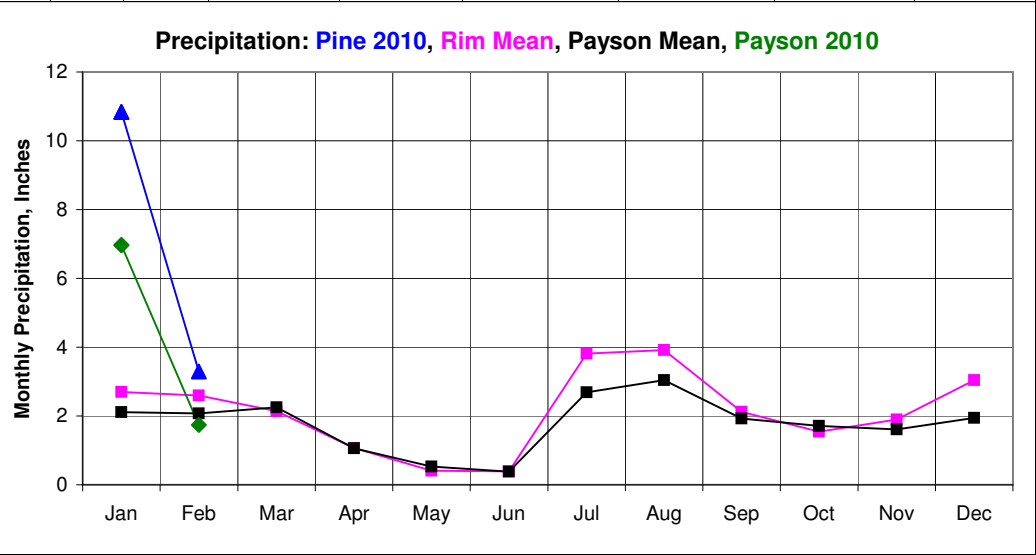

Payson February precipitation was a bit under average & the Rim about 0.7" above average. Added to December, 2009, this winter has been wet. We hope that March will be above average. The Webber Creek precipitation gage (USGS) just east of Milk Ranch Point recorded a total of 3.06" moisture for February, as usual for winter storms, fairly close to the Pine Home gage. Note that the temperature ranged from 24 to 60 degrees F, both recorded near mid-month, that most storms developed from the SW with the highest wind speed at 38 mph during the second storm.
