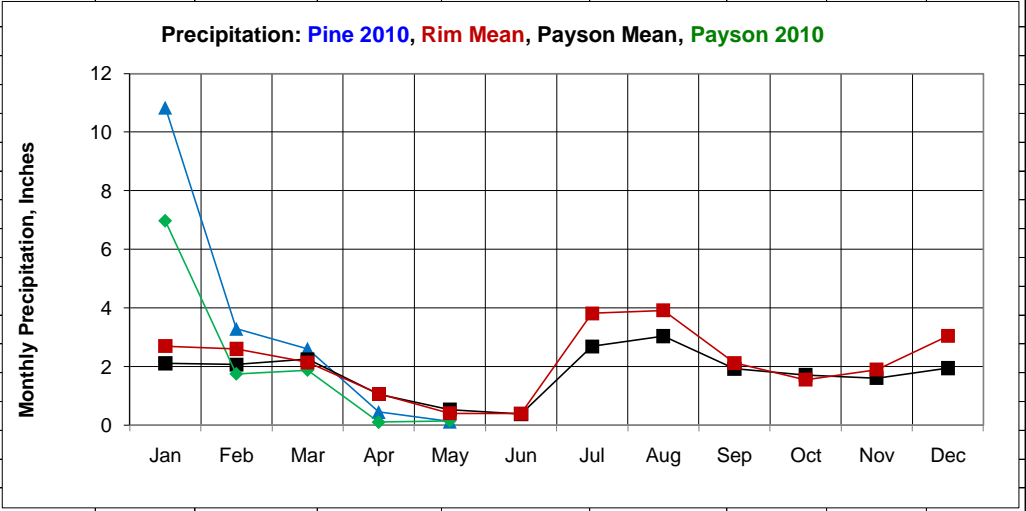

Note the Rim area was 0.3-0.4" below average for May. With June being the lowest precipitation month of the average year, we can only hope for an early monsoon (July & Aug) with average rain. Remember that last year's monsoon was very dry. Ponderosa pine is growing vigorously (note the "candles" of green at ends of each branch), still drawing on the available soil moisture from winter precipitation. Stage 2 Conservation level coming soon?
